Served as Head of Surgery at Konstantopouleio General Hospital of Nea Ionia "Agia Olga" for 18 years and as Professor of Surgery at the University of Cyprus (2017-2021). He is also a Visiting Professor at the Medical School of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (NKUA). Currently, he is Director of the Department of Surgical Oncology and Hepato-Biliary-Pancreatic Surgery at Metropolitan Hospital in Athens and Medical Director of the same hospital. He has authored three books with international publishers and published 250 articles with more than 65,000 citations and an h-index of 84. For the fifth consecutive year, he has been included in the list of the top 2% of scientists worldwide, according to the Stanford University ranking (USA).
