#### In Summary:

Kosmas Iliadis, MD PhD FECTS is a Greek and UK TRAINED General Thoracic Surgeon.

He graduated from the National and Kapodistrian University Medical School in Athens (1982), received his Cardiothoracic training (1985-1992) within the Athens Chest Hospital Tzaneion Hospital 1985-1990 and Cardiothoracic Centre of Liverpool (UK) 1991-1992, as a clinical fellow.

He moved to HYGEIA Hospital Department of Athens in 1992 working as a Senior Registrar where he organized the thoracoscopic Department. His training was completed in (1994) Memorial Hospital NY and (1997) at Santa Margarita Hospital in Marseille (France) where he was trained on Laser stent placement (Dumon) expanding his specialize on Interventional Bronchoscopy.

He became vice Director of the Thoracic Surgery Department in 1997 and as a Director of this Department in 2000. He performed the first VATS procedure in Greece and the first VATS Lobectomy (2009) on a 3 years old boy. He is interested in Interventional

Bronchoscopy using Laser and placing stents. He performed the first worldwide suturing of a ruptured Trachea Bronchoscopically using ordinary instrument. EACTS 2016 (Amsterdam) and Annals of Thoracic Surgery( 2019)

Minimal invasive surgery in his main interest VATS and RATS procedure having done more than 600 VATS Lobectomies. Hygeia General Thoracic Surgery Department became the leader in VATS procedures in Greece. He was the president and the organizing Surgeon of 4 courses with theoretical and practice on cadavers concerning Thoracoscopic Lobectomy and Segmenectomy.

He became the President of the Greek Cardiothoracic Society (2022-2024).
