In summary:

Dr. Constantinos Mavrantonis is a Colorectal Surgeon. He graduated from the Athens Medical School in 1987 and completed his General Surgery residency at the Aretaieion University Hospital, where he also earned his PhD. He subsequently completed a Fellowship in Colorectal Surgery at the Cleveland Clinic Florida, USA.

He currently serves as Director of the 6th Department of Surgery at Hygeia Hospital and is a member of the hospital's Scientific Board. Dr. Mavrantonis is a nationally recognized expert

in colorectal surgery and has performed the country's largest series of laparoscopic and robotic colorectal procedures, including laparoscopic and robotic specialized procedures such as CME right colectomy and Transanal Total Mesorectal Excision (TaTME) for rectal cancer.

From 2005 to 2012, he was Chief of Surgery at "Henri Dunant" Hospital of the Hellenic Red Cross, where he also served as Vice-Chairman of the Scientific Committee. He has been a Committee Member of the ASCRS Colon and Rectal Surgery Educational Program and served on the Editorial Boards of Clinics in Colon and Rectal Surgery and Techniques in Coloproctology.

Dr. Mavrantonis has also served as Vice-Chairman of the Board of the Hellenic Society of Medical Studies, as a member of the Board of Directors of the Hellenic Red Cross, and as a faculty member in colorectal surgery at the European Surgical Institute in Hamburg until 2022.

He has been an invited speaker at numerous scientific meetings across Europe and the United States. He has authored over 140 free papers and published 19 scientific articles in peer-reviewed medical journals, with a total of 2,994 citations. He has also contributed several book chapters to surgical textbooks.

Dr. Mavrantonis is the Founder and Chairman of the NoDE Institute (Network of Doctors' Education), a nonprofit organization dedicated to providing access to specialized postgraduate hands-on training and surgical proctorship. He also leads an annual medical mission team of doctors and nurses to Africa.
